Oliver Spreader

This spreader was a bequeath from the late Stephen Arbuckle. It is an Oliver, Model 160 made in USA in 1960. Designed as a tow behind with the moving chain floor driven off right wheel and the flail spreaders driven off the left wheel. Controls are via the shift handles protruding out the front that allow operation from the tractor.



Now fully operational and in working condition – but unlikely to spread any more muck !

Restored by Robin Kelso over the last six months. Restoration involved a strip down, sand blast, new tyres, painting, reassembly and Oliver logos.

This machine looks like it just came off the factory floor ! - good restoration job Robin.
